1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The organizing authority is the Surf City Yacht Club, Surf City, NJ USA. (SCYC)

2 Inspection and Measurement

Sails, blades, and boats may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Note that numbers and letters drawn on the sail with permanent ink pens are not legal. Refer to <http://www.laserinternational.org/sailnos.htm> for detailed instructions.

3 Eligibility and Entry

Competitors must be members of the International Laser Class. Those who are not members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority or join online.

4 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

5 Schedule of Events

5.1 Schedule:

Monday, August 21

9:30-10:30 Registration and breakfast at SCYC

10:30 Skippers meeting
11:30 First Warning

Dinner will be available immediately after racing.

Tuesday, August 22

07:00-08:30 Breakfast at SCYC

10:00 First warning signal, races to follow. Awards ASAP after last race.

Dinner will be available immediately after racing.

5.2 Seven races are scheduled for this event. The number of races held each day will be at the discretion of the race committee.

5.3 No warning signal will be made after 15:00 on the final day of the regatta

6 Registration

Competitors should register in advance by completing online registration. Online registration is available at SCYC's website (<http://www.seyc-nj.org>)

7 Fees

7.1 The entry fee is \$100. US. A late fee of \$15 US will be charged beginning August 7th.

7.2 The entry fee includes 2 breakfasts, snacks for on the water, post-race dinner on Monday and Tuesday and a tee shirt.

8 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration.

9 Courses & Racing Area

9.1 Courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

9.2 The racing area will be on the bay west of SCYC

10 Scoring

10.1 Scoring will be as provided in RRS 90.3.

10.2 Seven races are scheduled for each fleet. A minimum of 1 race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10.3 A boat's worst score will be discarded when 5 or more races are completed in her fleet.

11 Awards

In the radial fleet, awards will be given to the top 5 finishers. In the 4.7 fleet; awards will be given to the top 3 finishers.
